

WATER SAVVY PARKWAY TRANSFORMATION PROGRAM

The intent of the Water Savvy Parkway Transformation Program is to replace turf grass in residential parkways with attractive drought tolerant landscaping to improve water use efficiency in our community, at no cost to the participant.

GUIDELINES & REQUIREMENTS

Before signing this application, please read and review all program guidelines and requirements listed below. Failing to meet program requirements can result in denial of program participation.

- Parkway project area must have living turf grass (the parkway is the strip of landscape between the sidewalk and the street) and be located within Cucamonga Vally Water District's (CVWD) service boundaries.
- Program only applies to transformation of parkway landscapes. Customers looking to renovate other turf areas on their property should review information about the turf replacement rebate available through SoCal WaterSmart, at www.socalwatersmart.com.
- This program shall not apply retroactively. Pre-existing projects of turf removal, which were initiated and/or completed prior to the approval of CVWD, shall not be eligible for participation in this program.
- Customers who participate in the Parkway Transformation Program agree to maintain the project site for a minimum of five (5) years. Participants who fail to maintain the parkway or who revert back to a turf parkway landscape within five (5) years may be required to refund the cost of the project amount.
- Participation in the program is voluntary and does not constitute any representation or promise of any quantified water savings whatsoever. CVWD is not making any commitment, representation or warranty as to the viability of the plants, operation and maintenance of the drip irrigation, or the resulting appearance of the transformation.
- CVWD reserves the right to refuse and/or deny an application based upon the location of the project, existing conditions of the parkway, non-eligibility, overall program funding, and site evaluation conducted by licensed contractor.
- Participant agrees to allow CVWD to publicize efforts/results associated with this project. This may include photos or video of the project. However, customer's personal information will not be publicized.
- Participant must work with CVWD's licensed contractor, EcoTech, Inc. CVWD will not cover work done by outside partners.
- This program is partially grant funded through the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and restrictions may apply.
- CVWD will cover eligible costs for the complete parkway project, including landscape design, turf removal, landscape and irrigation installation, materials, and labor for parkway relandscaping. Should customers request enhanced parkway upgrades, customers will be responsible for covering any increased costs that fall outside of the program parameters.
